Core Visual Redesign for LexisNexis AU

The current visual design of the *LexisNexis AU* interface has been improved to simplify navigation. The background colour has been removed to leave a clean white area making your search tools more visible and easier to find. We have incorporated customer feedback regarding the navigation menu and have moved it to the left side which is also aligned with website best practices. The new visual interface design is more intuitive and easier for you to use.

New Homepage for Less Frequent Visitors

A new homepage has been created for *LexisNexis AU* users who may visit the platform less frequently. A quick and easy search tool together with an added list of “My Sources” results in the most commonly used functions of *LexisNexis AU* now available at your fingertips.

Search Form Order Improved

The order of the search list has been changed according to customer feedback and usage. For search items selected most often they will now appear at the top making it easier for you to find what you want, faster. The open text fields next to the search items have also been reorganised to assist you navigate the page more easily.

Combined Commentary and Services Tab

These tabs have been merged together for simplicity and ease-of-use. The form fields and single source list have been combined into one whilst retaining their same functionality. This combination of tabs will prevent confusion and will make finding relevant sources easier for you.

Addition of the Source Tray Functionality

From the “View” button on the ‘Browse Sources’ tab you will be presented with source tray identifying the sources you have selected. This tray is then pinned to the underlying source directory allowing you to see what you have selected whilst still navigating. This makes it easier for you to see the sources and manipulate them as you work.
