

Further information on the new "Copy Link" feature

General description:

- On LexisNexis AU, a Copy Link icon in the delivery options will enable a user to copy a URL for a results list.
- On LexisNexis AU, the Copy Link icon will also display in document view for sources that appear on a 'white list' — in general, these are sources that have stable document IDs following content updates. This will enable a user to copy a URL that goes directly to the document.
- The link will also work if the customer forwards it to a client or colleague, external to the customer's account — as long as the recipient has a valid ID and subscribes to at least one appropriate source. Authentication and normal billable events apply.
- This functionality also provides the ability for external applications such as TimeMatters and PC Law to bookmark links into Rosetta results lists and documents.

Combined sources:

If a customer has run a search over a combined source which consists of more than 200 sources — the Copy Link for the results list will re-run the search over only the first 200 sources.

“Related Content” links:

After following a Related Content link, if it shows a single document or if the user clicks a document link from the results list, the Copy Link icon will appear in the document screen provided the target source is in the white list. However, the Copy Link will not be available in the Results list.

“View More” links:

After running a search and going to a document, the Copy Link icon is available if the source is in the white list. However, if the user then opts to view a higher display unit in the document (by selecting an option from “View more” links), the Copy Link icon will no longer appear.

Searching within sections of a source’s Table of Contents:

If a search is run within sections of a source (selected in the Table of Contents via the Browse screen) — the Copy Link will not recognise the TOC sections. The Copy Link will re-run the search over the entire source.
