2. Downloading a LexisNexis eBook:

A: Instructions for a PC via the 'Adobe Digital Editions' application:

LexisNexis eBooks can be viewed on a PC via the 'Adobe Digital Editions' application. To install this application, please follow these steps:

- 1. You will need to have permission to install applications on your PC, if you do not have this permission please contact your IT administrator before starting.
- 2. Open the URL http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/ in your web browser.
- 3. Click 'Download Now' in the upper right corner of the page under the 'Next Steps' heading.
- 4. Click on the 'Install Now' link.
- 5. Click 'Install' on the resulting screen.
- 6. Follow the prompts until installation is complete.
- 7. During the set up process you will be asked to enter your Adobe ID or set up a new one. If you do not have an Adobe ID please create one now. Log in with your Adobe ID within 'Digital Editions'.

Once Adobe Digital Editions has been installed please follow these three steps to open the eBook on your PC:

- 1. Click on the link you have been sent via email.
- 2. Click on 'open' within the prompt that follows.
- 3. This will open up Adobe Digital Editions and download your new eBook.

B: Instructions for iPad/iPhone :

LexisNexis eBooks can be viewed on an iPad/iPhone via the application Bluefire Reader. To install the Bluefire application and open your book, please follow these steps:

- 1. On the iTunes store either on your iDevice or on your computer, download and install the application 'Bluefire Reader'.
- 2. Open your new application on your iDevice. On initial access you will be asked to enter your Adobe ID. Please create an ID or enter one if you have already created it.
- 3. Forward this email to an email address that can be accessed on your iPad.
- 4. Click on the link you received in your email.
- 5. Click on 'Open in BlueFire Reader'.
- 6. The book will then be downloaded in BlueFire Reader.
