

It is a condition of publication that the author owns all copyrights to the article and assigns those rights to the *Australian Journal of Human Rights (AJHR)*. This entitles the *AJHR* to publish the article in print and online through its publisher, LexisNexis (LN).

By agreeing to this document, the author warrants that the manuscript: is their own work; does not infringe the rights of any third party; and is not defamatory or obscene, all in accordance with the laws of NSW.

In the case of joint authorship, the signatory warrants that he or she has been authorised by all co-authors to sign this document on their behalf.

LN retains copyright ownership of the printed/formatted version of the *AJHR* and the articles contained within.

LN grants that:

The author can publish copies of the article on the author's personal website or the website of the institution they work for, as long as:

- It does not extend to Austlii or other commercial publishers;
- There is a delay of one month from the publication by LN of the *AJHR*; and
- There is a notification that the *AJHR* is published and made available by LN.

The author can publish copies of the published work which forms part of the *AJHR* on other websites for the purpose of meeting funding/open access requirements, as long as:

- It does not extend to Austlii or other commercial publishers;
- There is a delay of twelve months from the publication by LN of the *AJHR*;
- There is a notification that the *AJHR* is published and made available by LN; and
- The author obtains the express written permission from LN for each article.

Authors can publish unedited, unpublished, original versions of the work which have not yet been submitted to LexisNexis for publication. In the case that an unedited, unpublished, original version of the work is subsequently published by LexisNexis, the individual contributor author must:

- Insert a notification retrospectively that the work has since been published by LexisNexis and the work is the original work of the author and in no way associated with the published copy of the work by LexisNexis; or
- Replace the original copy with the published copy of the work by LexisNexis and insert a notification that the work has been published by LexisNexis and is reproduced with permission.
