Bills Monitor – displays all bills currently before the Commonwealth, NSW, Vic and Qld Parliaments. These browser pages are maintained by LexisNexis® Capital Monitor®.

Bills Monitor provides you with a brief overview of the subject of the bill and what stage it has reached - with quick access to the bill, its second reading speech, explanatory memorandum and the act, when it is passed. Notes are also provided if the bill is amended, negated (defeated) or withdrawn, with details of when that happened. Soon after the bill receives Royal Assent, the reference is migrated across to the associated Acts Assented page.

Acts Assented – displays all current year's acts as they receive assent from the Commonwealth, NSW, Vic and Qld Parliaments. These browser pages are maintained by LexisNexis® Capital Monitor®.

Proclamations – all Commonwealth proclamations registered are available immediately and archived by year.

Additional services include:

Tax Rulings – quick access to all tax rulings every Wednesday at 2pm. Includes an archive of all rulings by type.

High Court Judgments – quick access to judgments as soon as they are handed down.
