To effectively supervise the various teams a system is required that management can and will ensure that the task is undertaken within a reasonable time frame. It is also necessary to allocate a priority rating and a backup system should a task be due when the responsible staff member is away on leave. After the initial template system has been created in Lexis Affinity, this occurs with a click of the button.
