- **Lexis® for Microsoft® Office**

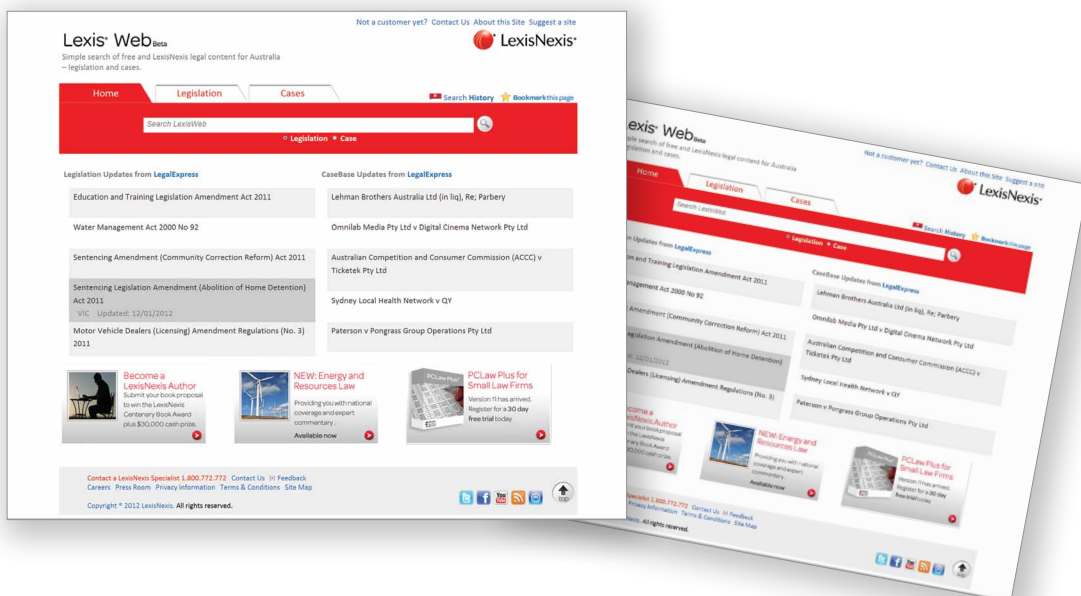

The development of mobile sites for our online solutions meaning you can access them in a format optimised for mobile access.

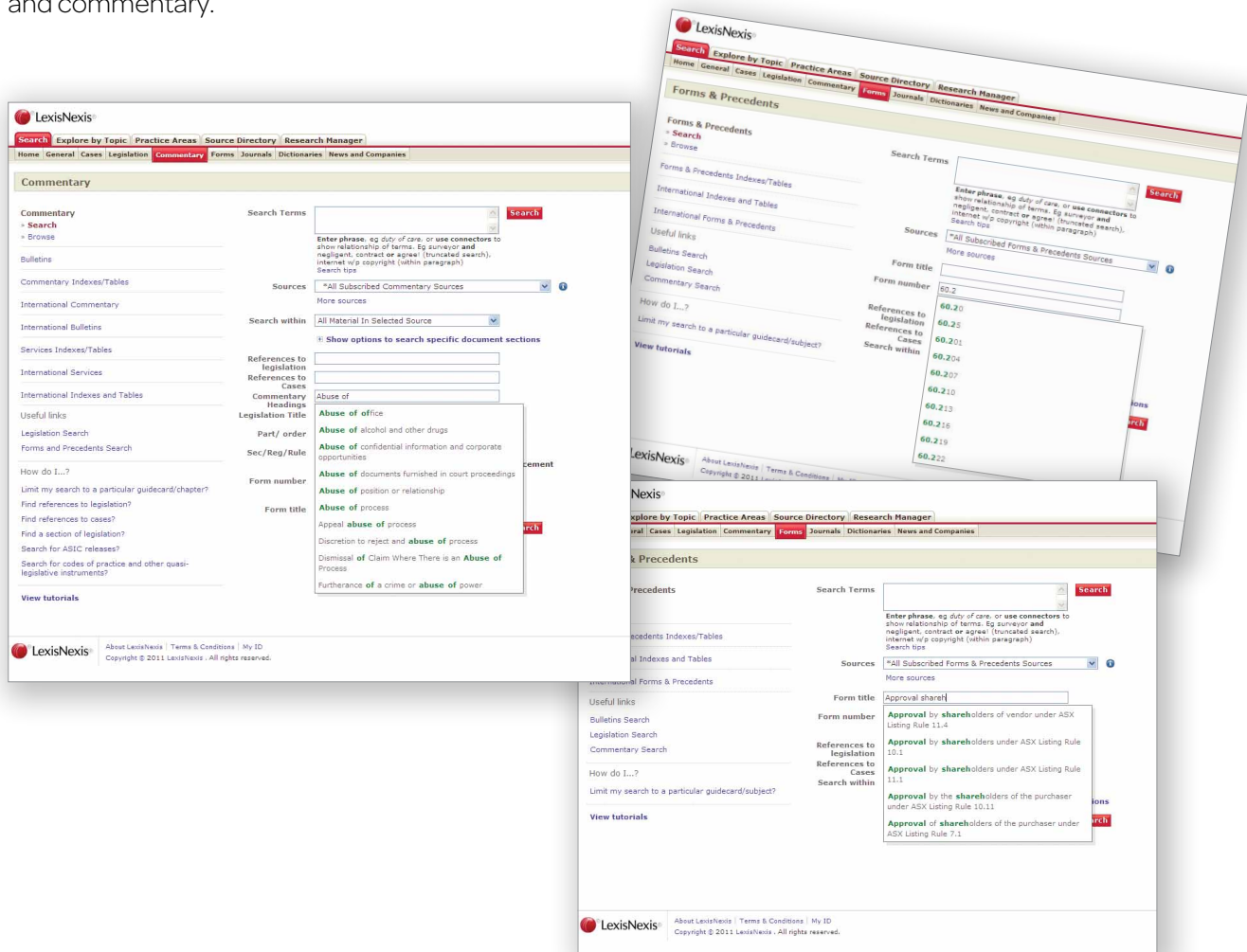

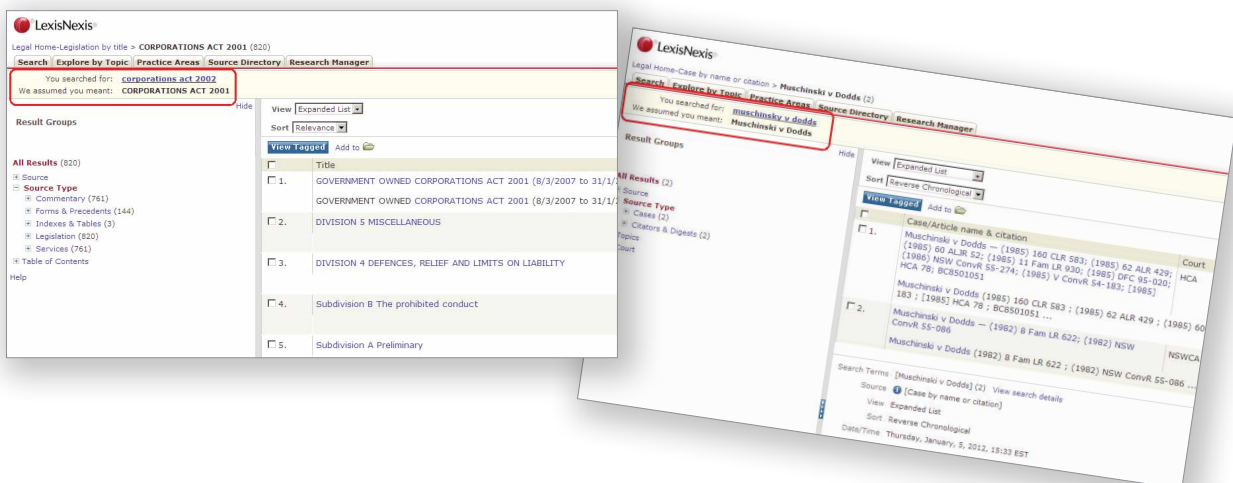
Search Assist on LexisNexis AU
