Description: This is a precedent clause for inclusion in a broader employment agreement, governing the refund for an employee's use of his or her own vehicle in the course of employment.

Refund for usage of employee

1. Motor vehicle and fuel

- (a) Subject to subclauses (b) and (c), the employer will provide a motor vehicle in the performance of the employee's duties and the employer will refund the employee for such usage.

Size of engine

Under 2500 cc

Over 2500 cc

- (b) Travel to and from home to work.
- (c) The employer will not provide a motor vehicle for the employee's private use (as verified by a verified log book or other record on a per kilometre basis).
