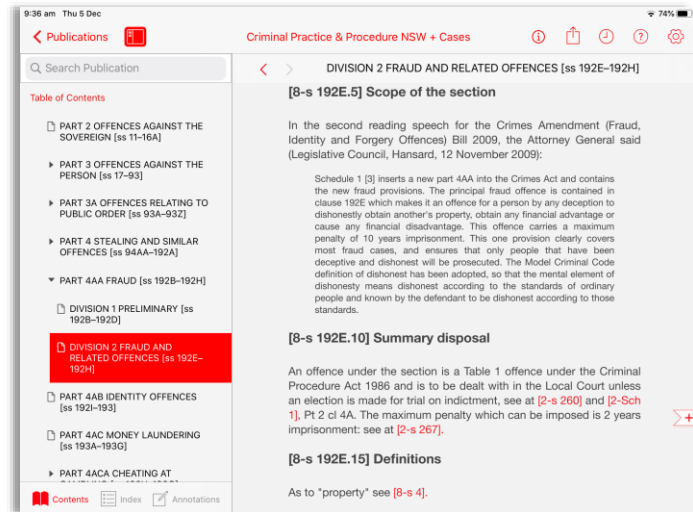
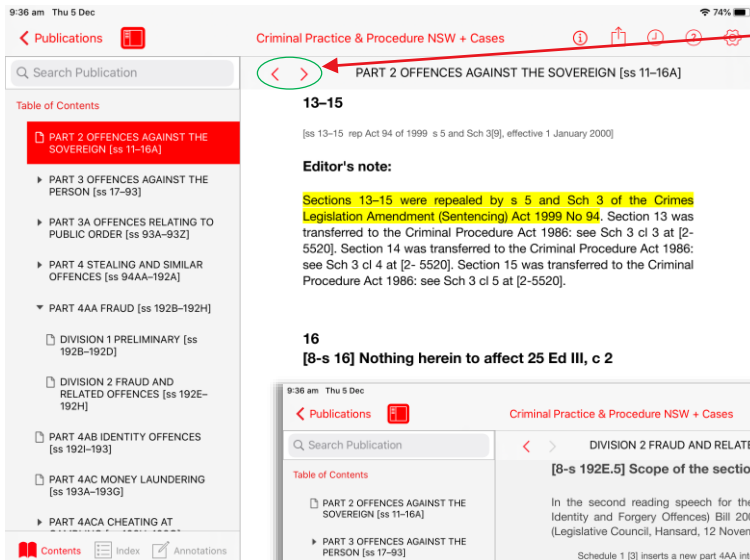

General

- Back/forward navigation enhancements
 - *Addresses problem:* user cannot return directly to their previous location in a title. Instead, they are taken to the top of the relevant document.

Note: images taken from iPad but the feature is supported on each OS.



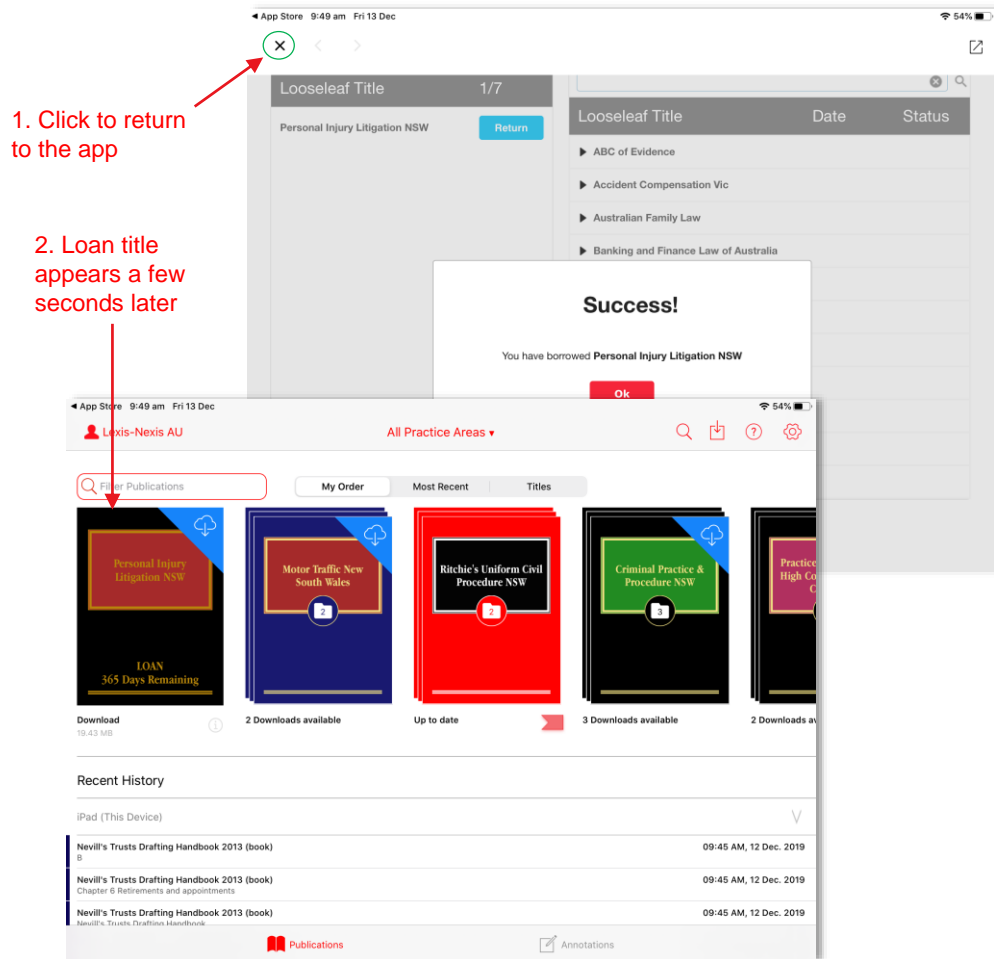

General

- App refreshes after exiting the Digital Library
 - *Addresses problem:* user cannot see their recently borrowed titles after returning to the app, suggesting an error occurred or the loan was unsuccessful. They must wait for a few minutes for the app to refresh and display the new loan title.

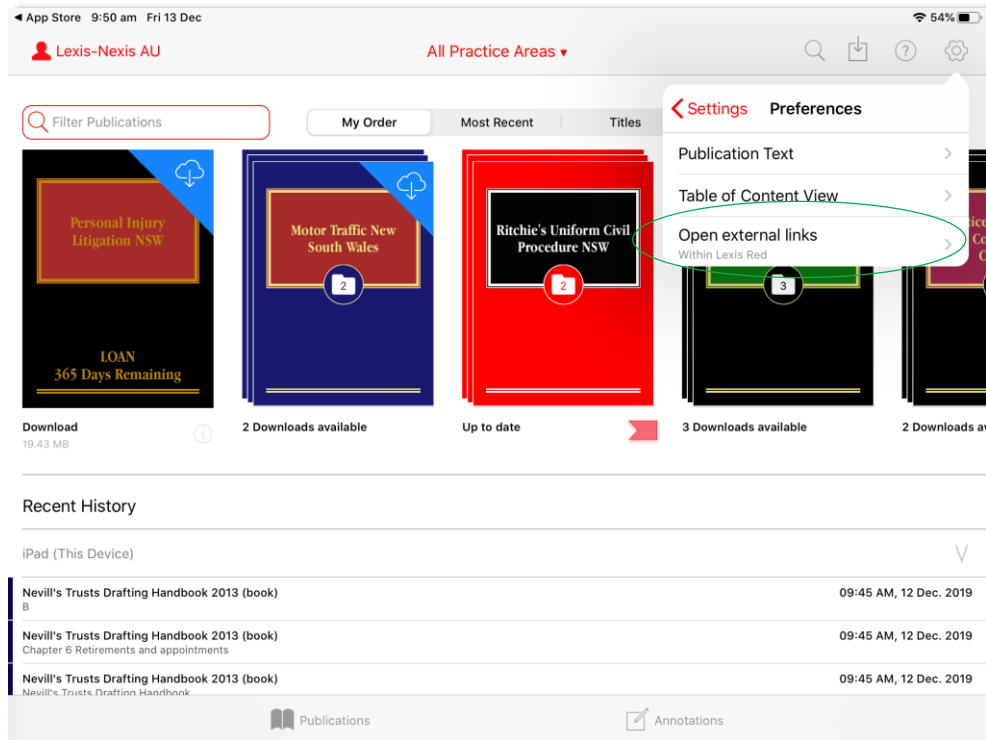

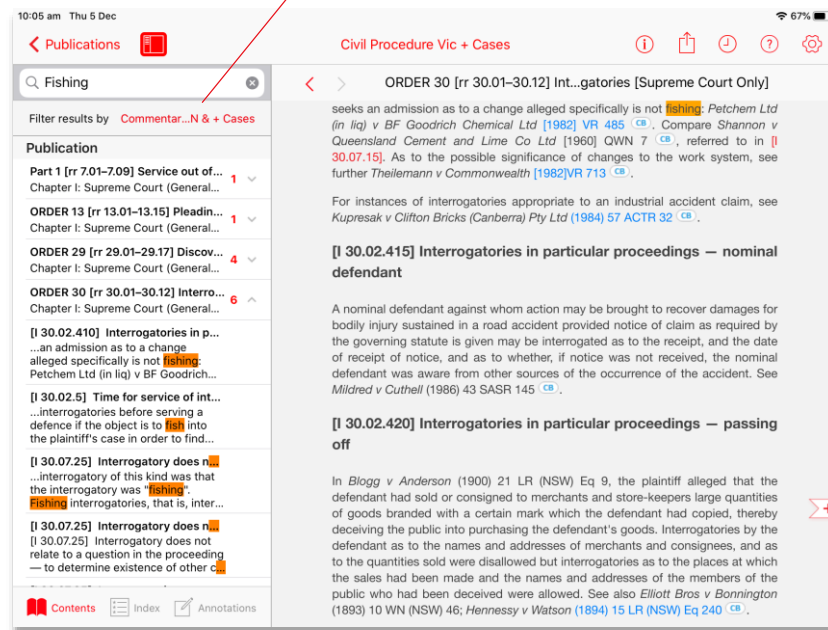
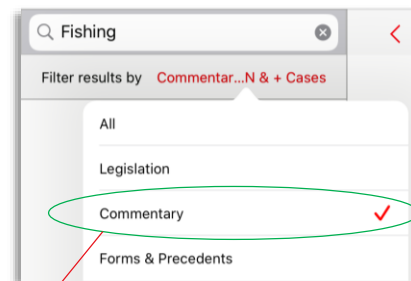

Bug fixes

- Search commentary filter – applies to all app versions
 - *Addresses problem:* authored annotations (grey-background commentary) do not appear when searching with the commentary filter.

- Highlighted search terms appear in shared documents
 - *Addresses problem:* Search terms highlighted in the app remain highlighted when the document is converted to PDF for sharing and printing.

[3-s 59] The hearsay rule — exclusion of hearsay evidence

(1) Evidence of a previous representation made by a person is not admissible to prove the existence of a fact that it can reasonably be supposed that the person intended to assert by the representation.

[subs (1) am Act 46 of 2007 s 3 and Sch 1, effective 1 January 2009]

(2) Such a fact is in this Part referred to as an **asserted fact**.
