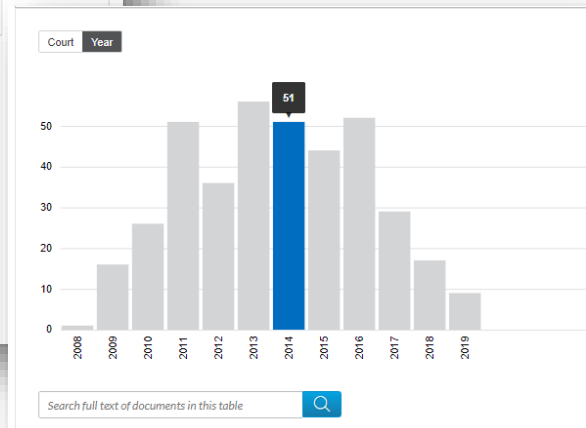
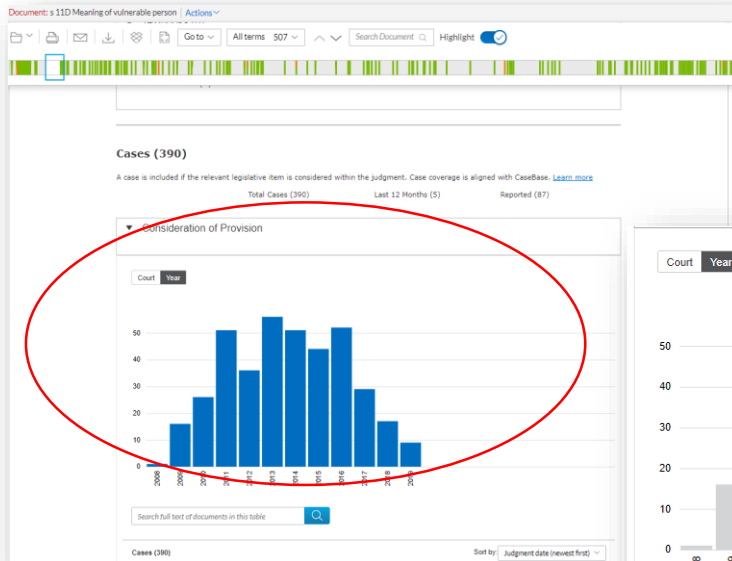

LawNow Plus: Data Visualisations

LawNow Plus™ documents now feature Data Visualisations, providing users with a graphical view of cases considering an instrument or provision by year or court.

Users can select a year or court to filter cases table.



NEW! Did You Mean? – 100% roll-out

The new Did You Mean? Feature has been rolled to 100% of customers.

When Lexis Advance detects a potential misspelled term, it will make correction suggestions.

Results for: murder purspoe
Did you mean: murder **purpose**

Clicking on the “Did you mean:” corrected text link will re-run the search in the suggested spelling.

User must “opt in” by the clicking the corrected text link. The Did You Mean suggestions are not included in the results by default.

Known limitations:

- Focuses on common typos, but not all misspellings.
- Dependent on usage of phrase across our data.
- Exceptions include: text in “quote marks”, terms in ALL CAPS, terms ending with “.”, terms containing a hyphen.
- Feature will be continually refined and enhanced.

Search: Include All Terms (multiple missing terms)

"Include all terms" link appears when there is more than one missing search term. Search will be rerun with an "and" connector between all terms.
