# Important updates in Lexis Red 3.19

## Overview

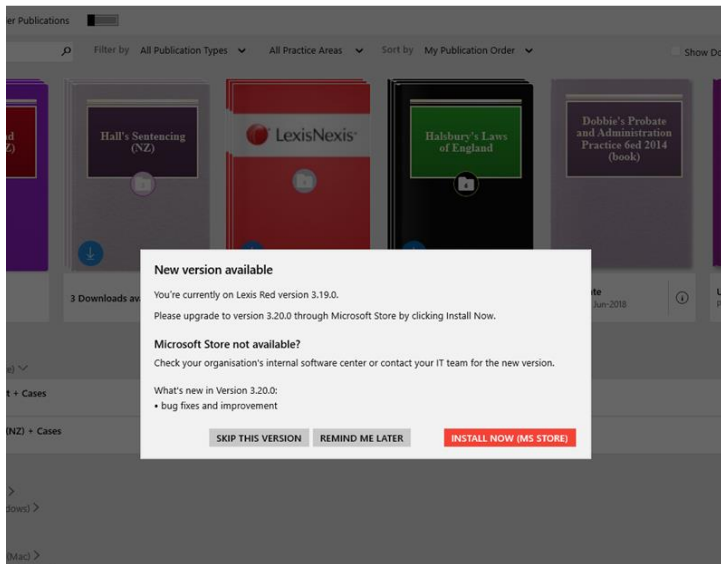
- New version popup update for Windows
- New publication info on publication screen and iModal

App version 3.19 will be available on Windows, iOS and Mac but not Android as we are making significant upgrades to the Android app's architecture.

# Update to new version popup notification on Windows

**Problem statement:** When a new version of the app is released, a pop up appears directing the user to the MS Store to download the latest version of the app. However, the notification does not cater to users whose access to the MS Store has been blocked by their organisation.

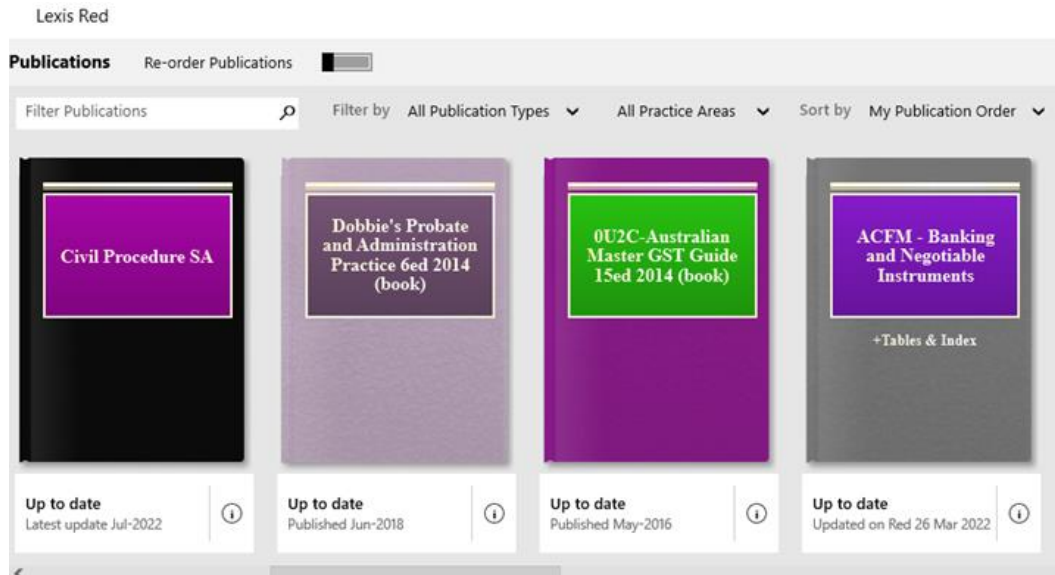
**Solution:** The wording of the new version pop up has been updated to let users know that they should check their organisation's software centre or contact their IT team for the new version of the app if their access to the MS Store is blocked.



# New publication info on publication screen and iModal

**Problem statement:** Customers wanted more meaningful publication information and labels.

**Solution:** The publication details appearing on the publication screen and iModal have been updated and customised for each content type.

# New publication info on publication screen and iModal

## New publication dates for AU/NZ publications

### *Looseleafs*

**Latest update:** Date of the latest editorial update to the publication. This can be compared to the latest update date on Lexis Advance and the Print versions of the same title.

**Updated on Red (cover) and Last updated on Lexis Red (iModal):** Date this publication was last published to Lexis Red. This is a system date and may bear no relationship to the currency of the publication. Publications are re-published to Lexis Red for various reasons including editorial updates and for technical reasons.

### *Books + Legislation*

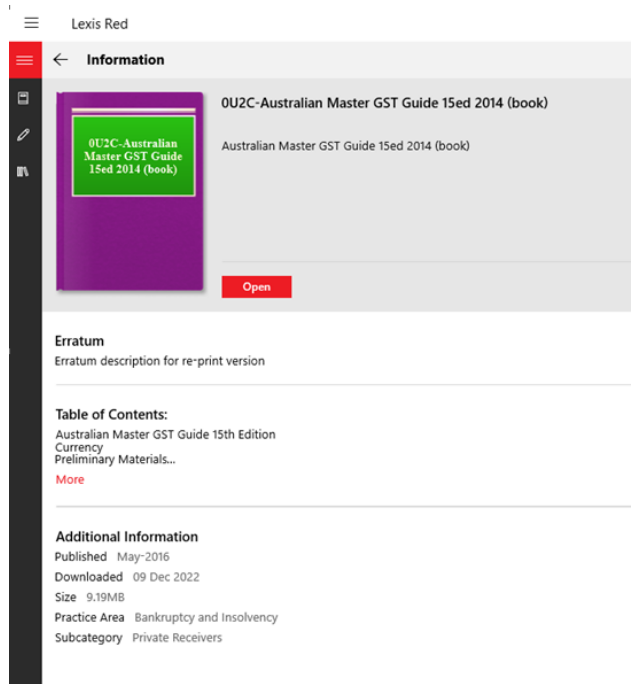
**Published:** Publish date of this edition of the book. This can be compared to the published date on Lexis Advance and the Print versions of the same book.

### *All content types*

**Downloaded:** Date user downloaded the update to their device.

# New publication info on publication screen and iModal

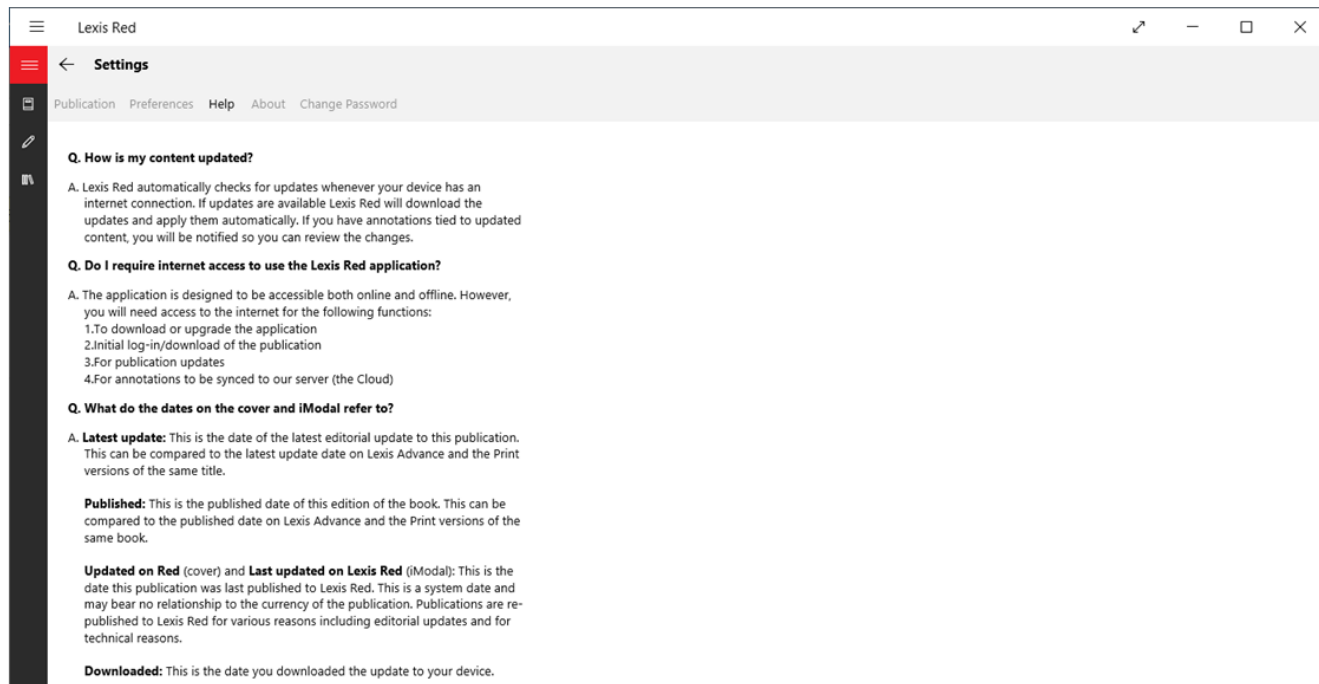
## Books iModal



- Replacement of guidecard information with table of contents
- Addition of optional erratum message
- Addition of Published and Downloaded dates
- Removal of version number

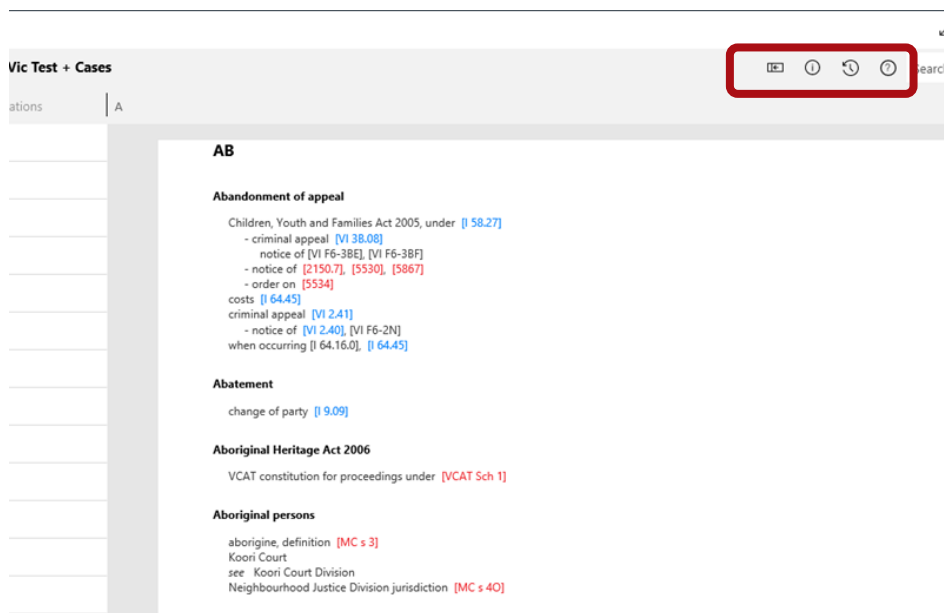
FAQs updated to include:

# 'Share' menu hidden when user selects Index tab in publication

**Problem statement:** Some Mac/iOS users, unaware that selecting 'share/save to PDF' delivers the contents of the tab they were last browsing, shared/saved the 'Index' tab rather than the contents tab as they intended.

**Solution:** To avoid confusion, the share menu is now hidden when a user selects the Index tab on any device.
